

## 2023 Key Stage 2 September Checking Exercise Requests Summary (Check Your Performance Measures Data)

Below is a breakdown of the number of cases requested during the 2023 key stage 2 (KS2) September checking exercise.

The table is sorted by total number of cases, broken down by main categories then 'other' categories.

We have listed common reasons why cases are unable to be accepted in each category to assist you when making future requests - please note this list is not exhaustive.

### Some common overall reasons cases were unable to be accepted are:

- \* Relevant 3rd party/external evidence not provided within the first 6 pages of evidence submitted. Anything beyond the 6th page of evidence is not read or considered in the decision making process.
- \* No 3rd party/external evidence provided. Internal school narrative is not deemed to be 3rd party/external evidence but is counted towards the 6 page evidence limit.
- \* Evidence uploaded but not submitted. Evidence has to be submitted to confirm which documents the institution would like considered.
- \* 3rd party/external evidence provided, but situation described does not meet criteria specified in the checking exercise guidance
