2024 Key Stage 4 June Checking Exercise

We wrote to you on 20 May 2024 to inform schools and colleges that the 'Check Your Performance Measures Data' (CYPMD) service had been launched.

This service will use a new portal to administer the 2024 Key Stage 4 (KS4) June Checking Exercise. There is also a new help desk facility which will support you throughout the 2023/24 checking exercise process.

In addition to this, to assist schools and colleges with their participation in the 2024 June checking exercise we shared the 2024 KS4 June Checking Exercise Guidance and the 2023 KS4 June Checking Exercise Requests Summary Document.

We have now produced further guidance on how to use the new portal to help you prepare for the checking exercise opening. You can access these in the KS4 June further guidance section on the CYPMD Help Centre here.

The CYPMD portal will be accessed using a **DfE Sign-in** account. This is the same secure sign-in system used by many DfE services. **Details on how to create an account can be found here**.
