- * No 3rd party/external evidence provided. Internal school narrative is not deemed to be 3rd party/external evidence but is counted towards the 6 page evidence limit.
- * Evidence uploaded but not submitted. Evidence has to be submitted to confirm which documents the institution would like considered.
- * 3rd party/external evidence provided, but situation described does not meet criteria specified in the checking exercise guidance
