This document describes the format of the 16 to 18 Value Added CSV file which is made available to schools and colleges on the CYPMD portal in November. It contains provisional 16 to 18 Value Added data.

16 to 18 Value Added: student and qualification level data (value added data file (CSV)

This CSV file contains student details as well as 16 to 18 Value Added scores by qualification type, size and subject for each student in scope of the measure, so there may be several rows for each student. This CSV file gives a breakdown of student and qualification level data used in the 16 to 18 Value Added calculation.
