

2026 Check Your Performance Measures Data (CYPMD)

Key stage 4 (KS4) June pupil level csv data file

This document describes the format of the KS4 pupil level data available to schools and colleges on the KS4 CYPMD portal.

The KS4 June pupil level data will be split into two separate downloadable csv files:

- **‘Pupil included’** csv file – this will contain only pupils who will be included in the calculation of your school or college performance measures
- **‘Pupil non-included’** csv file – this will contain only pupils who will not be included in the calculation of your school or college performance measures, for example a pupil who joined your school or college roll after 2026 spring (January) census day, or those 15-year-olds who are not in year 11.

The pupil level data format will be the same between the two CSV files.

If you do not have any non-included pupils, you will not have the option to download the non-included pupil csv file.
